GREETING:

W H E R E A S it is enacted by "The Acting Judges Act of 1878"
that the Governor in Council of Our State of Queensland may
grant Leave of Absence to any Judge of the Supreme Court of
Our said State, on account of illness or other sufficient
cause, and may, by Commission in Our name, appoint any person
qualified to be a Judge of the said Court to act temporarily
in the place of a Judge absent on leave: AND WHEREAS the
Governor in Council of Our said State has, in pursuance of the
power so vested in him, seen fit to grant Leave of Absence from
the Twentieth day of June to the Twentieth day of December,
inclusive, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred
and ten, to Our Trusty and Well-beloved His Honour Mr. JUSTICE
VIRGIL POWER, a Judge of the said Supreme Court and the Central
Judge, and to issue this Commission: NOW KNOW YE, that WE,
having taken into consideration your loyalty, integrity,
learning, and ability, have thought fit to appoint You, and do
hereby appoint you, the said LIONEL OSCAR LUKIN, being a
Barrister of the Supreme Court of Our said State of five
years! standing and upwards, and being a person qualified to be
a Judge of the said Supreme Court, to act temporarily as a
Judge of the said Supreme Court and as the Central Judge, in
the place of the said Judge absent on leave during the period
aforesaid, to have, hold, exercise, and enjoy the said Office
during good behaviour, together with all the rights, profits,
privileges, and advantages thereunto belonging or appertaining.
